MAJOR CHAINS

All the major supermarkets state that they have a commitment to stocking Fairtrade goods. Links are provided to their websites to enable you to check on their ranges.

Bargain Booze – stock La Trilla Chilean Fairtrade wines, plus Cadburys chocolate, KitKats, JP Juice and Ben & Jerry's icecream, which are all Fairtrade

By default, many shops will stock Fairtrade products, often without realising, especially the smaller convenience stores and the shops at petrol filling stations. Cadburys Dairy Milk, chocolate buttons, drinking chocolate and cocoa are all Fairtrade. KitKats and, later in 2012, Maltesers will be approved. Green & Blacks chocolate, Tate & Lyle's sugar ranges and Ben & Jerry's icecreams also carry the Fairtrade logo and are readily available in small outlets.
